Once logged in you will be able to perform other tasks such add posts.



## **Accessing the Login page**



This link is also available at the bottom of every page of the website. Simply click on the "Site Login" menu text as shown below



# **Logging In**

When you access this link you will see a page similar to the following



Enter your user name and password and you will be taken to the Colchester Harriers administration dashboard.

Your user name will normally be the initial of your first name and your surname. So if "Anthony User" was a user of the site his login would be "auser". You can also use your register email address as your login name


# Forgotten password

If you forget your password simply click on the "Lost your password?" link and follow the on screen instructions. If the user account you provide is valid then you will receive an email with instructions on how to unlock your account and set up a new password For your security and the security of the site please don't share your password with anyone, we can easily add additional users to the site

### The Dashboard

When you first login you are normally taken to the site dashboard. This gives access to all site configuration options.

PLEASE NOTE: For most users most of these options are inaccessible or heavily protected. It is difficult if not impossible for most users to break the site, so please take care but don't be too afraid of what might happen.

## Logging out



When you have finished what you are doing it is best to logout. The site will automatically log you out when all sessions have been closed but it is a good practice to log out manually. In the top right hand corner of the screen you will see "How are you <your username>?". Click on this and select "Log Out"
